 - There is a need for the new high school
 - Parents need to tun the communications
 - Parent volunteers in Stow and Bolton have already agreed to be the reps
 - Looking for a parent volunteer within Lancaster
 - School can communicate via social media
 - Feasibility phase right now, it will end when the state approves (MSBA granting source)
 - Schematic design phase, meeting with project managers regularly to work on design
 - Project is estimated at \$912/square foot
 - 53.9% MSBR reimbursement rate on qualified costs (capped per/sq ft cost)
 - Cost estimate will be on 5/12, will be reported to tax payers on 5/18
 - 10% of building cost is the cap for all the grants related to site work. Site work is typically 20% of the building cost
 - Tracking ~26% from MSBR on eligible cost
 - Deadline to MSBA is 7/28
 - Preferred schematic design had some good indicators from MSBA, indicated will participate the EMS program, along with an early childcare program.
 - Enrollment number is 985 students, capacity is 1,038
 - Town will have to vote to incur the debt
 - No vote will pause the process. Chapter 71 section 16 D covers the debt. 16 N covers funding through a regional election. School district can run a regional election. If majority votes across three

town, then it passes

- MBSR has 120 days from presentation to funding
- Debt exclusion vote, for a prop 2.5 override, middle of September
- If debt incursion fails, then district moves to the bottom of the MSBR
- What does construction look like
 - New school will be built on the baseball fields.
- Vote to incur debt will be in September
- Stow is going down, Lancaster is growing, Bolton is stagnant
